2.Declarations of interest 19/22

3.To approve the minutes of previous meeting 20/22

- The council approved the minutes of the ordinary meeting of the 18th January 2022.

4.To approve the list of payments 21/22

- The council agreed the list of payments and explanations provided where appropriate.

5.To receive a report from the VOGC representative Councillor Penrose 22/22

- The councillor gave updates regarding a number of ongoing issues that he was aware of. He updated the meeting in relation to the traffic survey that had recently been conducted in the village. From the figures it appeared that there were minor speeding violations at certain times of the day but not enough to warrant any sort of intervention from the safety camera partnership or Police.

6.To Receive updates from Councillors regarding a survey conducted at Cosmeston and ideas for a play area in Sully 23/22

- The clerk updated the meeting regarding the Cosmeston Survey. The closing date for submissions was the 14th February and once the figures and information was available it would be distributed to councillors
- Councillor Bowring had recently received a quote for a new children's play area in the village and was waiting on some others. Once available they will be distributed to Councillors for information/action

7.To discuss and resolve upon an internal auditor for the council's accounts 24/22 2

- The community council agreed to appoint Mr Paul Egan to examine the Councils accounts before audit

8.To discuss and resolve upon the provision of a new base for a new picnic bench at the community field 25/22

- The community Council agreed to provide a new base with the picnic bench being provided by a member of the community

9.To discuss and resolve upon any planned events for the Queens platinum jubilee including the provision of a beacon 26/22

- There were discussions, of a general nature, of various activities that are/may take place. Councillors are looking at costings for a beacon

11.Receive reports from representatives on external bodies 28/22

- Councillors gave either verbal or written reports, where appropriate, regarding Sully School, Evenlode School, Chemical Advisory Board and the Community Liaison Panel

- Michael Garland gave an update regarding the work of the Saving Sully Group and their attempts to get village green status for the Glebe Fields in Sully. Fund raising was ongoing with a go fund me page on Facebook been set up. This had raised some £1430.00 so far but was well short of the anticipated initial spend required.
- Bob Penrose, as a result of a question from the public, intimated that the Sully Library Trust
- were still working to find land available for the provision of a health centre etc
- There was a general discussion regarding the various groups in the village and the need for unity. It was agreed that meetings should be arranged in the near future
