### **REPORT OF THE CLERK TO THE FEBRUARY 2017 MEETING OF THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL**

My report to the Community Council is as follows:

1. Jubilee Hall Storage – I met with the leader of the Beavers and Cub Pack this week and we discussed the storage available to them and it would appear that the position has been resolved to both parties satisfaction.
2. Jubilee Hall Hire – The Jubilee Hall is now used on every night of the week during term time.
3. Pavilion Hire – I met with the Scout Leader this week and there is every possibility in the not too distant future that a Scout troop may well start up in Sully and I showed him the Pavilion which it is possible that they could utilize on one night a week.
4. Blinds in Pavilion Viewing Room – The roller blinds in the Pavilion viewing room have now been installed.
5. Bird Boxes – An approach to the Community Council has been made by Chris Thorne and Rod Thomas to donate 50 bird boxes for the local children to place on land belonging to the Community Council i.e. the trees along the coastal path on south side of Sully Sports and Social Club as the coastal path and the play area.
6. The Community Council has received an approach from an individual to either buy or rent from the Community Council the land on the south side of Lavernock Road. He wishes to run a wood turning business from there and a meeting has been arranged to discuss the possibilities.
7. PAT Testing – The PAT testing has been arranged for later this week in both the Jubilee Hall and the Pavilion.
