## **REPORT OF THE CLERK TO THE MARCH 2017 MEETING OF THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL**

My report to the Community Council is as follows:

1. Blinds in Jubilee Hall – The roller blinds in the Jubilee Hall have been ordered
2. Elections – The elections will be held on 4 May 2017 and the Jubilee Hall will be used as a polling station on that day. Details of the timetable for the elections have been sent to all Community Councillors for their information.
3. Fly Tipping – There would appear to be an increase in the amount of fly tipping in the area and 2 matters have been referred to the Community Council over the past 2 weeks – one being a sofa deposited at the car park at the bottom of Burnham Avenue and the other one being fly tipping on Hayes Road. Both matters have been reported to The Vale of Glamorgan Council.
4. Roller – The Benford Roller will receive a basic service in the next 2 weeks mainly to clear the petrol tank and filters out which may have become dirty over the winter break.
5. Mowers – The mowers are in the process of having their blades re-ground although the contractor responsible for the machines advises me that one of them may not be able to be re-ground as there is not enough on the blade to do so.
